

In the Portfolio Capstone Portfolio option students are required to provide artifacts across the eight CACREP Core curriculum requirements as well as program specific areas (Mental Health, School, and Student Affairs). It is common that many of the artifacts students would like to use to demonstrate the competencies were completed in collaboration with peers. Since the portfolio uses a web-based platform it is critical, and ethical, that the collaborating peers are aware that their materials may be shared publicly online. Furthermore, to best represent all parties involved it is required that the materials are of the highest quality and therefore the final product uploaded into the online portfolio should reflect incorporation of the instructor's grading of such things as grammar, APA adherence, and technical requirements. Meaning, students must agree to collaborate on addressing instructor observations after the grading process has concluded in the original course.
